

ROYAL SALUTE RULES

General Barn Rules:

- 1 All entrance/exit gates MUST remain closed at all times.
- 2 Please use gate #3 except when parking your trailers, then use gate #2.
- If you bring your dogs on to the property, please make sure that they are on a leash at all times, and tied up when you are riding.
- 4 **Absolutely NO SMOKING** on property at any time
- Trailers can be parked here at Royal Salute at no charge if you have a horse(s) here. Please keep them clean and tidy.
- Saddles and bridles can be kept in the tackroom, all other equipment that you have must be stored in your trunk. Either in the barn aisle, or in the designated trunk area.
- 7 **NO FLIP-FLOPS OR OPEN TOED SHOES ALLOWED!!!!** Please wear appropriate footwear for your own safety.

REMEMBER TO CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR HORSE AND YOURSELF

Lesson Rules:

- 1. Any lesson cancelled with less than 24 hours notice will be charged, full lesson fee.
- 2. Please wear boots with a heel, breeches, **a shirt with sleeves** (no Tank tops) and your hair neatly tied back, and of course your hard hat.
- 3. If you are late you lose lesson time at your expense.

Riding Rules:

- Hard hats preferably with a harness MUST be worn at all times while mounted, (this is not only for your safety, my insurance requires it.)
- 2 Riders under 16 must ride with an adult present at all times.
- NO jumping without prior permission from Jackie as well as having an unmounted "ground" person. NO bareback without asking Jackie first.
- 4 Please try to stay out the way of a lesson that is in progress.
- No horse is to be jumped without being properly worked the day before. And it is not necessary to jump more than twice a week.
- If you plan to trail ride it is wise not to go alone and to let someone know the general location and direction that you are going, and the approximate time you will be gone.
- If Jackie Alkin is out of town, or not on the property, children under 16 must have a parent present while riding on Royal Salute property. (preferably have a parent within eye sight so if something was to happen it would be seen immediately, for example not sitting in the car in the parking lot.)

Other miscellaneous information:

- 1 Please try to have all your equipment marked with your name, that way nothing gets lost.
- If you leave anything out if will be confiscated and you will have to buy it back.
- The round pen may be used as a "short term" turnout (½ hour or less)this is when it is not being used for training purposes.
- 4 Please do not leave your horse unattended in the cross tie or wash rack areas.
